



## CITY OF SANTA ROSA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA TO AMEND SANTA ROSA CITY CODE CHAPTER 6-66, RENT CONTROL – MOBILEHOMES

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the City Council on Tuesday, November 29, 2022, at or after 5:00 p.m., utilizing a hybrid public meeting format. The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comment and recommendations prior to the City Council acting on the introduction of the above-mentioned Ordinance and amendment to Santa Rosa City Code Chapter 6-66, Rent Control – Mobilehomes.

The proposed amendments would (1) modify the permitted annual rent increases from 100% of CPI with a 6% cap to 75% of CPI with a 5% cap; (2) allow mobilehome park owners to raise the rent 10% on an in-place transfer (this occurs when a resident sells their mobilehome to another person); and (3) make other minor amendments to conform to changes in State law.

To slow the spread of COVID-19 and to protect the health of the public and staff, the City is conducting hybrid public meetings with in-person, streaming video and telephone options.
