RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A MICROCLOR ON-SITE HYPOCHLORITE GENERATOR SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Recreation and Parks Department has an urgent need to replace the failing Sodium Hypochlorite Generator System (liquid Chlorine) at the Ridgway Swim Center; and

WHEREAS, PSI Water Technologies, Inc. (PSI), of Milpitas, California, is the manufacturer representative and certified service provider in Northern California for the current system; and

WHEREAS, PSI said that the existing system is failing because it was originally undersized for the sanitizing needs of the Ridgway Swim Center, has exceeded its useful life expectancy, and is difficult to service and find repair parts

WHEREAS, PSI submitted a proposal which includes reusing some components of the existing system, which is helping keep costs down from a full replacement of the system; and

WHEREAS, the PSI proposal has been reviewed by the Recreation and Parks Department staff and it is recommended to accept as being in the City's best interest.

WHEREAS, Section 3-08.100(D) of the City Code provides that purchases of supplies, material, equipment and services may be made without recourse to competitive bidding requirements where the source of supply, necessary restrictions in specifications, necessary standardization, quality considerations, or other valid reasons for waiving competition appears; and

WHEREAS, Council is the award authority for a purchase with a not to exceed amount of \$140,932.50 and must approve the waiver of competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa waives competitive bidding pursuant to Section 3-08100(D) of the City Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the purchase of a new larger Microclor On-Site Hypochlorite Generator in the amount not to exceed \$140,932.50from PSI Water Technologies, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Council delegates authority to the City Manager or designee to execute a Non-Standard Agreement, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A to the resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to pay all claims for this purchase out of funding to JL Key 09781.
