



REJECT ALL BIDS– SANTA ROSA AVENUE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

BACKGROUND

This project will provide corridor improvements to Santa Rosa Avenue between Sonoma Avenue and Maple Avenue, including pedestrian facilities, Class II bike lanes, pavement surface treatments, landscaped median islands and various other items.

ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on June 23, 2022, and bids were received on July 26, 2022. A total of two (2) bids were received, ranging from \$2,550,501.80 to \$2,756,683.15. The low bid was 98% over the Engineer's estimate.
- Cost increases were attributed to unprecedented material cost increases and greater than expected traffic control prices.
- Rejection of all bids will allow the Transportation and Public Works Department to re-bid the project in late 2022 / early 2023

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, reject all bids received for Contract No. C01620, Santa Rosa Avenue Corridor Improvements.
