

Robust Recovery

 Revenue 100% of prepandemic levels with escalation



Revenue Recovery/ Fewer Riders



Short Range Transit Plan Regional Coordination

Efforts currently underway to improve regional coordination...

- Weekly meetings between Sonoma County Transit, Petaluma Transit, and CityBus
- Alignment of service levels for holidays between Sonoma, County Transit, Petaluma Transit, and CityBus.
 - Moving from regular weekday service on MLK DAY, President's Day, Day After Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and New Year's Eve to a Saturday level of service.
- Efforts to synchronize service changes across all Bay Area public transit agencies.
- Integrated service planning process to begin in next calendar year.

- 3. A Saturday level of service on Sundays




