

Solicitation of Interest / Notice of Funding Availability AFFORDABLE HOUSING INCENTIVE FUND PILOT PROGRAM TOTAL AMOUNT AVAILABLE: \$3,000,000

BACKGROUND: Through a competitive process, the City of Santa Rosa is seeking proposals for grant funds through the Affordable Housing Incentive Fund Pilot Program ("Program"). As part of the Housing Action Plan, adopted June 7, 2016, the City Council has allocated \$3 million to incentivize affordable housing production in the shortest timeframe. Proposals will be considered for all or a portion of the funds.

PURPOSE: The goal of the Program is to provide the most affordable housing, utilizing the least amount of grant funds, targeted to the lowest income level for the longest period of time.

USE OF FUNDS: Funds may be awarded for ownership and/or rental units in one or more of the following three categories:

- 1) Make direct payments to developers offering affordable housing units to offset cost of development impact fees or other project costs;
- 2) Purchase affordable housing contracts from multifamily housing developers combined with waiver of any applicable affordable housing impact fees; and
- 3) Purchase extensions on affordable housing contracts that are set to expire in the near future.

PROCESS:

- Proposal: To determine the feasibility and effectiveness of your funding request, please 1) summarize in narrative form why your project should be selected for funding based on the goal of the program and use of funds (see above); 2) complete the <u>Selection Guidelines for Funding Affordable Housing Developments</u> in MS Word form (if any section is not applicable, please write "n/a"); and 3) a <u>Housing Authority Ioan application</u>, if applicable.
