


- PO for Maintenance Parts (\$132,041)

Next Steps

- On-site work Began this Week (5/20)
- Goal is to have Operating Screens ASAP
- Misco to provide Repair Estimates for:
 - Parts-list (Purchase under BPO)
 - Labor (to be Completed under PW Contract)
- Return Mid-August for Final Work
- BPO to be used for Future Maintenance/Parts
- Additional BPOs for Key Equipment







Recommendation

It is recommended by the Water and Finance Departments that the Board of Public Utilities, by resolution, waive the competitive process and authorize award of a sole source Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) for furnishing parts as necessary to repair two (2) Andritz Aquascreen finescreens and specialty labor necessary to evaluate the system and identify parts required for the repair, to TW Associates, Inc. dba MISCOwater, Foothill Ranch, California, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.
