

# CONTRACT AWARD – SIX FIRE DAMAGED PARKS - RECOVERY

### **BACKGROUND**

This project will replace park amenities that were destroyed by the Tubbs Fire in the following parks and open space locations:

- Fir Ridge Park
- Nagasawa Community Park
- Francis Nielsen Park
- Rincon Ridge Park
- Rincon Ridge Open Space
- Parker Hill Rd Trail


### **ANALYSIS**

- The project was advertised on 12/9/2021; 5 of bids were received on 1/11/2022, ranging from \$1,471,254.00 to \$1,821,980.50.
- The low bid was 10.48% under the Engineer's estimate.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in March of 2022 and last 120 working days.

### RECOMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution: 1) award Contract No. C02248., Six Fire Damaged Parks-Recovery, in the amount of \$1,471,254.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Oak Grove Construction Co., Inc, of Petaluma, California, approve a 10% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$1,618,379.40; and 2) authorize the appropriation of \$1,675,000.00 from the General Fund reserves for the Six Fire Damaged Parks – Recovery project, and increase General Fund federal and state grant revenue by at total of \$1,675,000.
