

CONTRACT AWARD – FIRE DAMAGED ROADWAY LANDSCAPING

BACKGROUND

This project will replace irrigation facilities and landscaping components within City right of way in the Fountaingrove and Coffey Park neighborhoods that was destroyed by the 2017 Tubbs Fire.

- The project was advertised on 12/21/2021; seven (7) of bids were received on 2/8/2022, ranging from \$6,009,025.20 to \$7,712,495.39.
- The low bid was 9.78% under the Engineer's estimate.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in May of 2022 and last 231 working days.



- Staff is requesting \$5,850,000.00 from the general fund
- Funds will be returned to General Fund upon FEMA reimbursement
- Non-reimbursable activities and local share costs funded through PGE settlement funds and available funds, respectively

RECOMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution: 1) award Contract No. C02300, Fire Damaged Roadway Landscaping, in the amount of \$6,009,025.20 to the lowest responsible bidder, Bortolussi & Watkin, Inc. of San Rafael, California; 2) approve a 10% contract contingency for a total not-toexceed contract amount of \$6,609,927.72; and 3) appropriate \$5,850,000.00 from the General Fund reserves for the Fire Damaged Roadway Landscaping project, and increase General Fund federal and state grant revenue by a total of \$5,850,000.00.
