




#### Lake Pillsbury Storage



Lake Mendocino Storage





# PG&E Potter Valley Project License – Schedule for Surrender Application

- PG&E is currently operating under annual license from FERC subsequent to expiration of their prior license term
- May 11 FERC requested that PG&E submit plan and schedule for surrender application for project
- July 8 PG&E submitted to FERC a schedule
  - Proposed Schedule Pending approval from FERC, 30 months for surrender plan and application


### Santa Rosa Cumulative Drought Reductions



- In June 2022, Santa Rosa residents reduced water use by 17% in compared to 2020
- From July 2021 June 2022, water use has been reduced by 17% compared to 2020

## Water Use Reductions: 2021-2022

- Stage 3 enacted June 29, 2021
- Our customers have saved over 1 Billion gallons to date
- We have doubled efforts as we head into our hottest time of the year
- Customer response and participation remains strong
  - Audits, rebates, water waste reporting, etc.


