

## FY 2023/24 Budget and Program Considerations

- City Council focus on housing/homeless continues
- CDBG-DR projects continue
- Housing Vouchers
- HOME ARP
- Compliance monitoring increase due to new units



### FY 2023/2024 Funding Assumptions

### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Real Property Transfer Tax- \$2.125M to Housing
  - City plans to fund Homeless Services with one-time ARPA funding in 23/24 (second year); all RPTT to Housing
- Impact Fees- \$1.4M
- Loan repayments \$400K
  - High last year due to Lantana Project loan paydowns (one-time)
- Compliance Fees- \$150K
- Federal Funds- HUD has not yet released funding for CDBG, HOME and HOPWA
- Housing Choice Vouchers
  - Total budget increase 10.5% to HAP, and 15% to Admin Fee to assist HA's with inflation



### FY 2023/2024 Expenditure Assumptions

### Preliminary assumptions, subject to change

- Increases to Rental Assistance and Trust expenditures
  - Citywide salary and benefits increases for staff
  - Rental Assistance Payment increases
  - No new positions added
