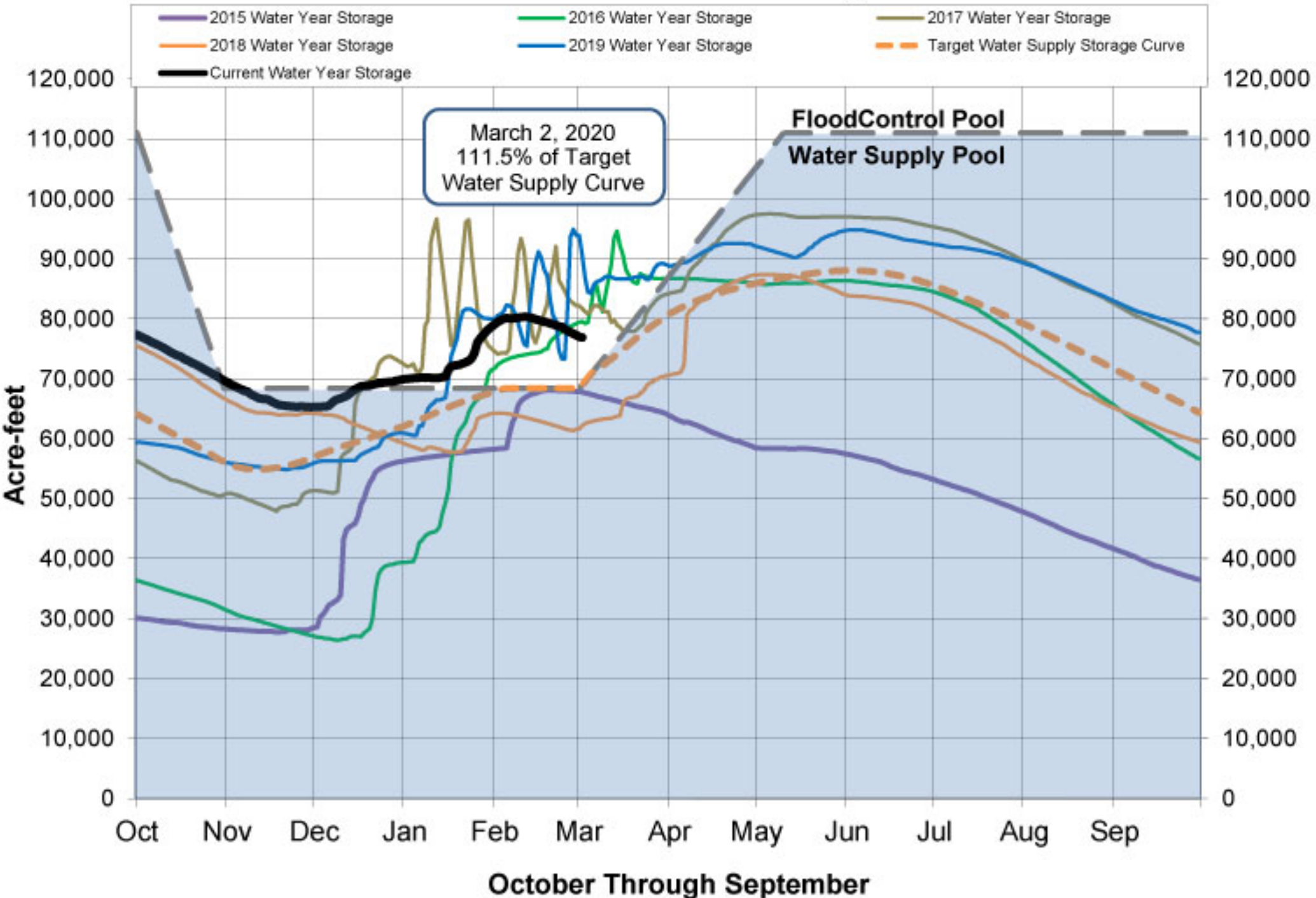

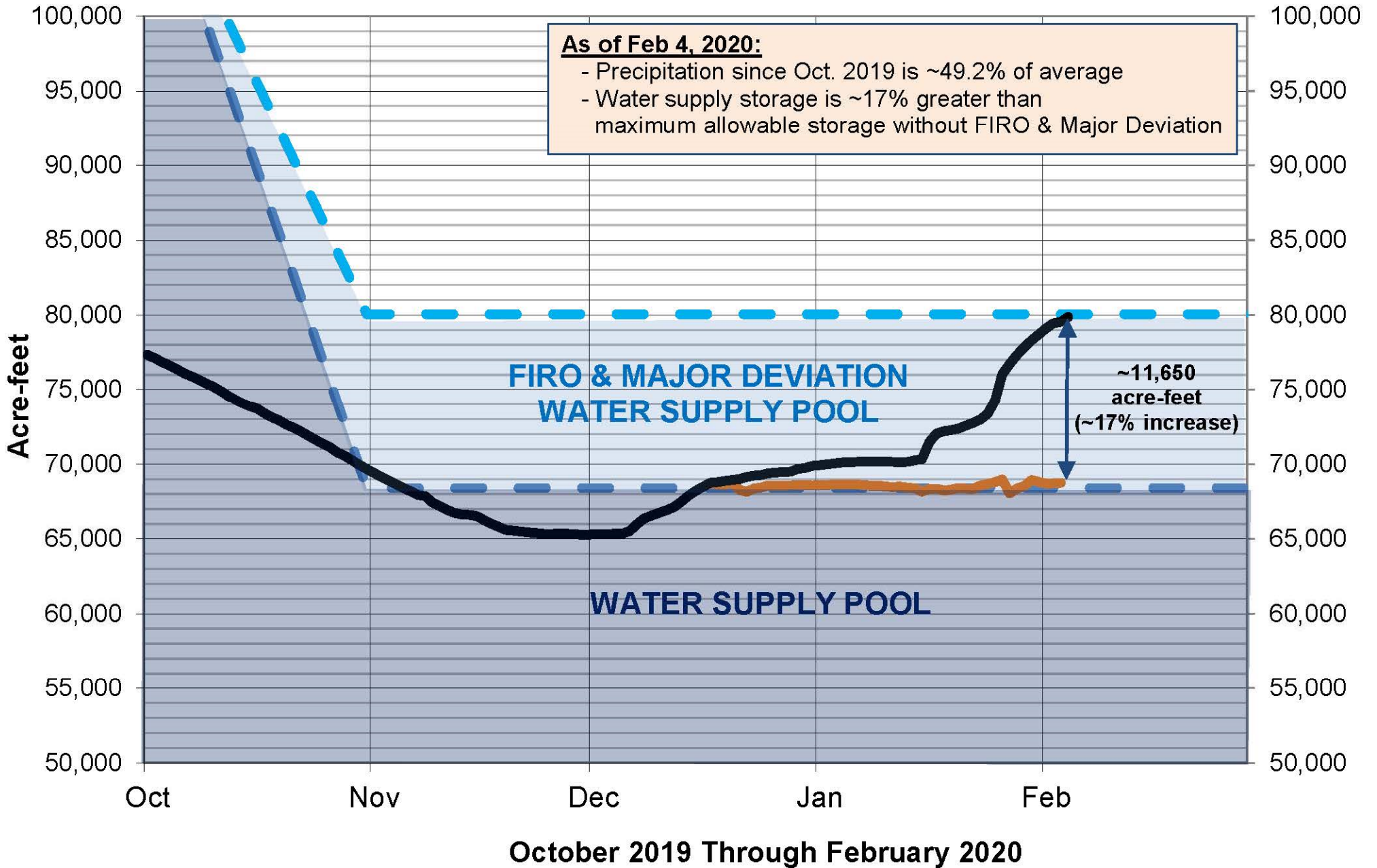

Lake Mendocino Storage

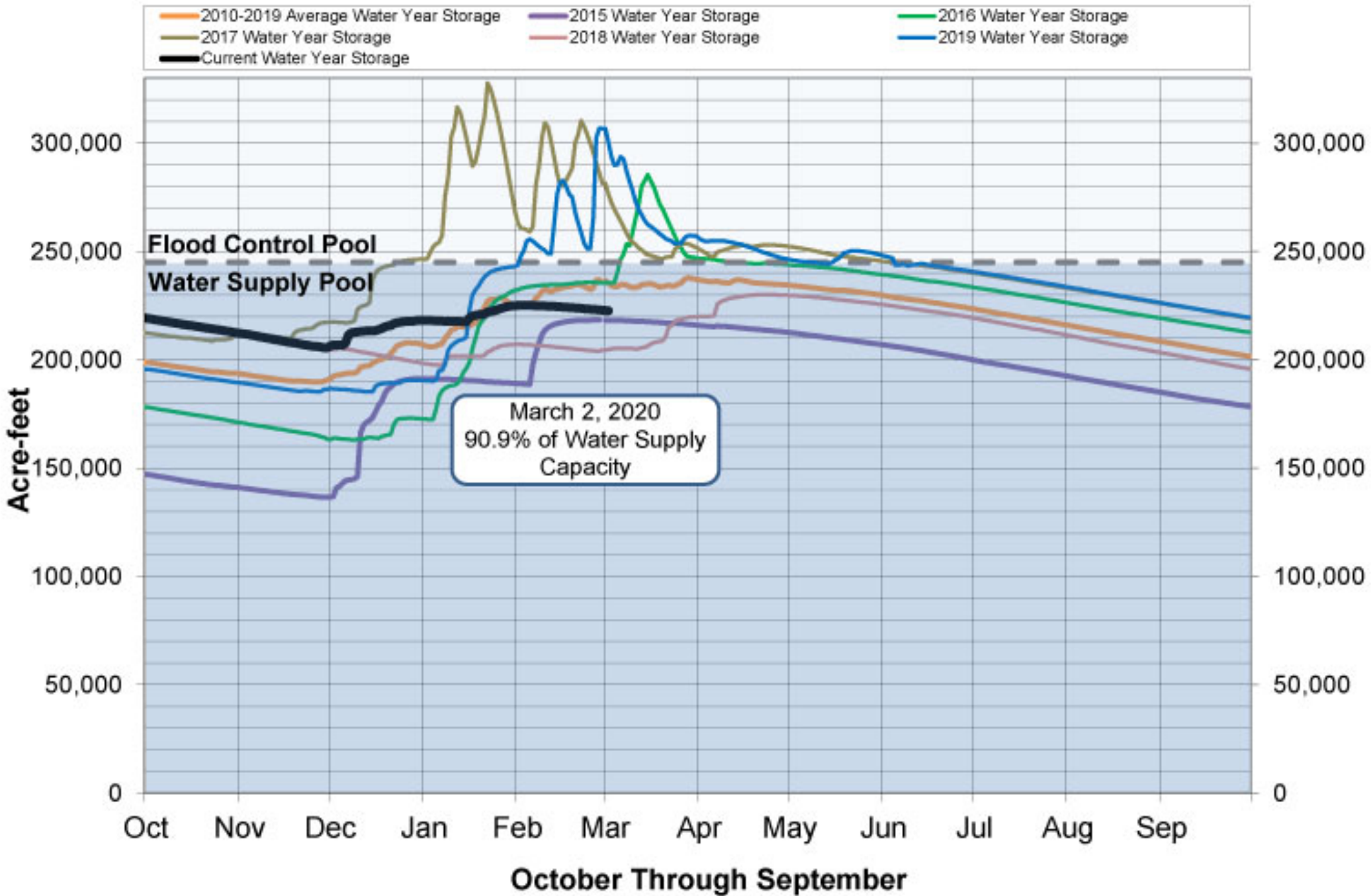


Lake Mendocino Storage

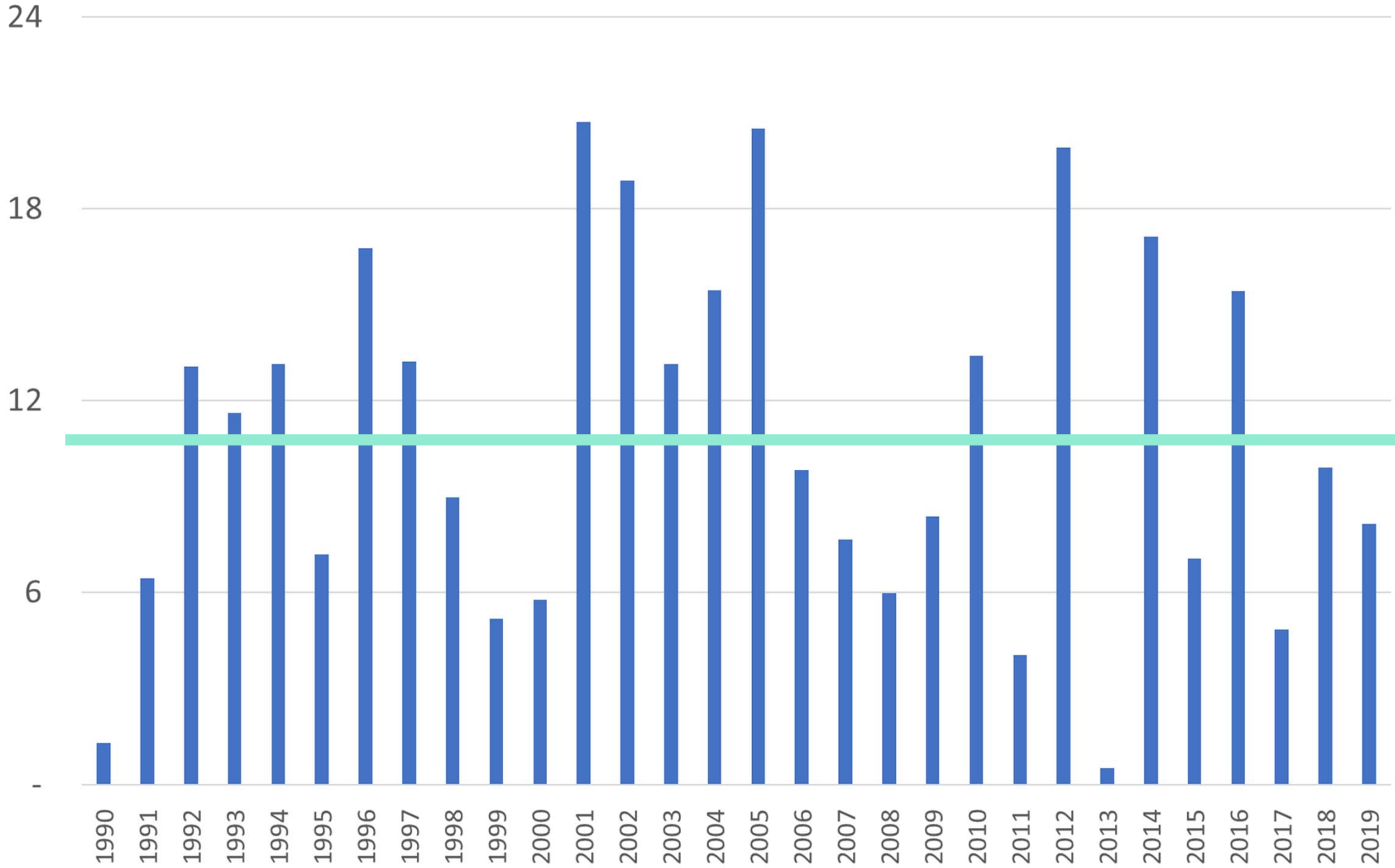


Lake Sonoma Storage



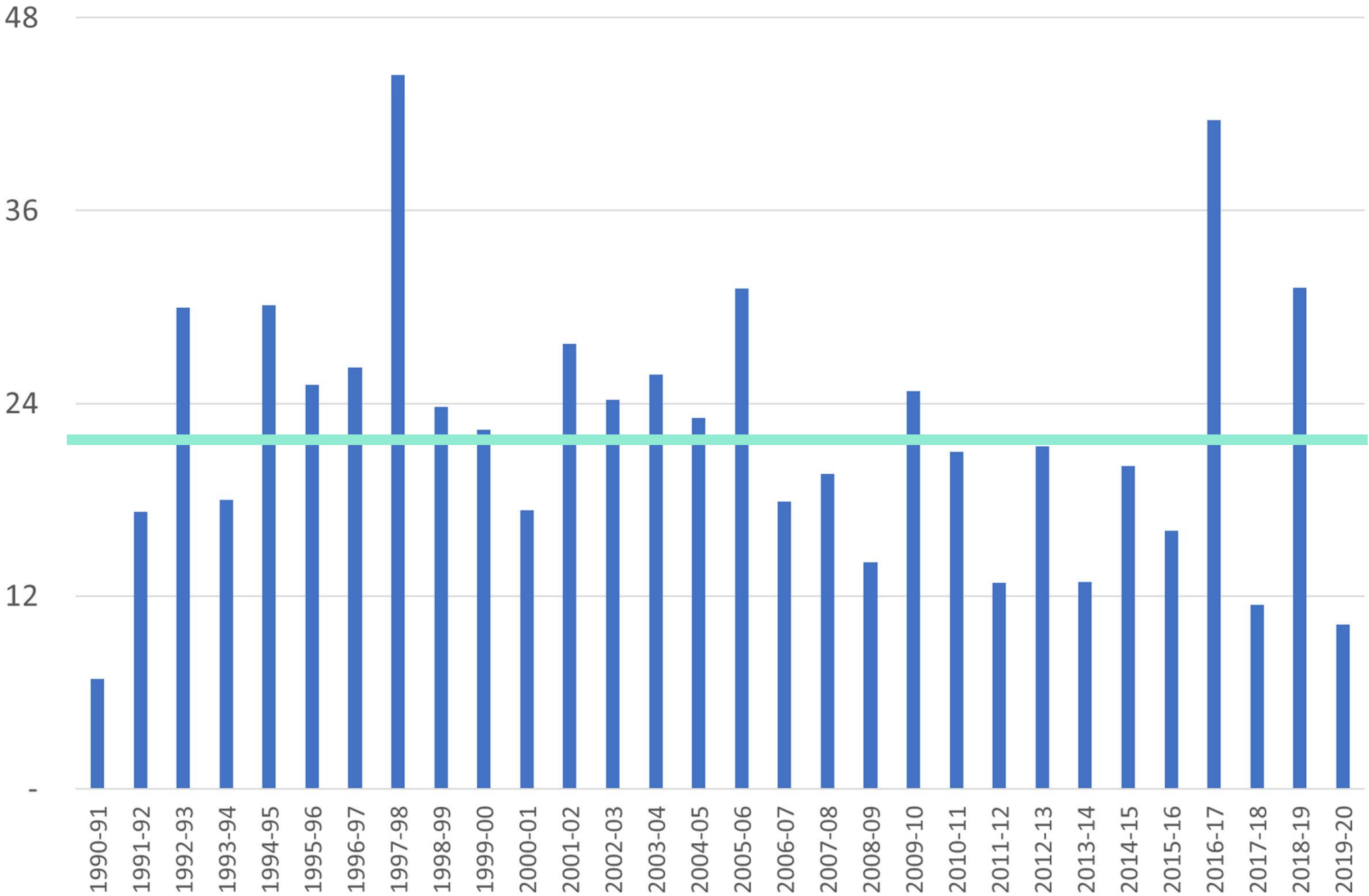
Rainfall for Oct-Dec

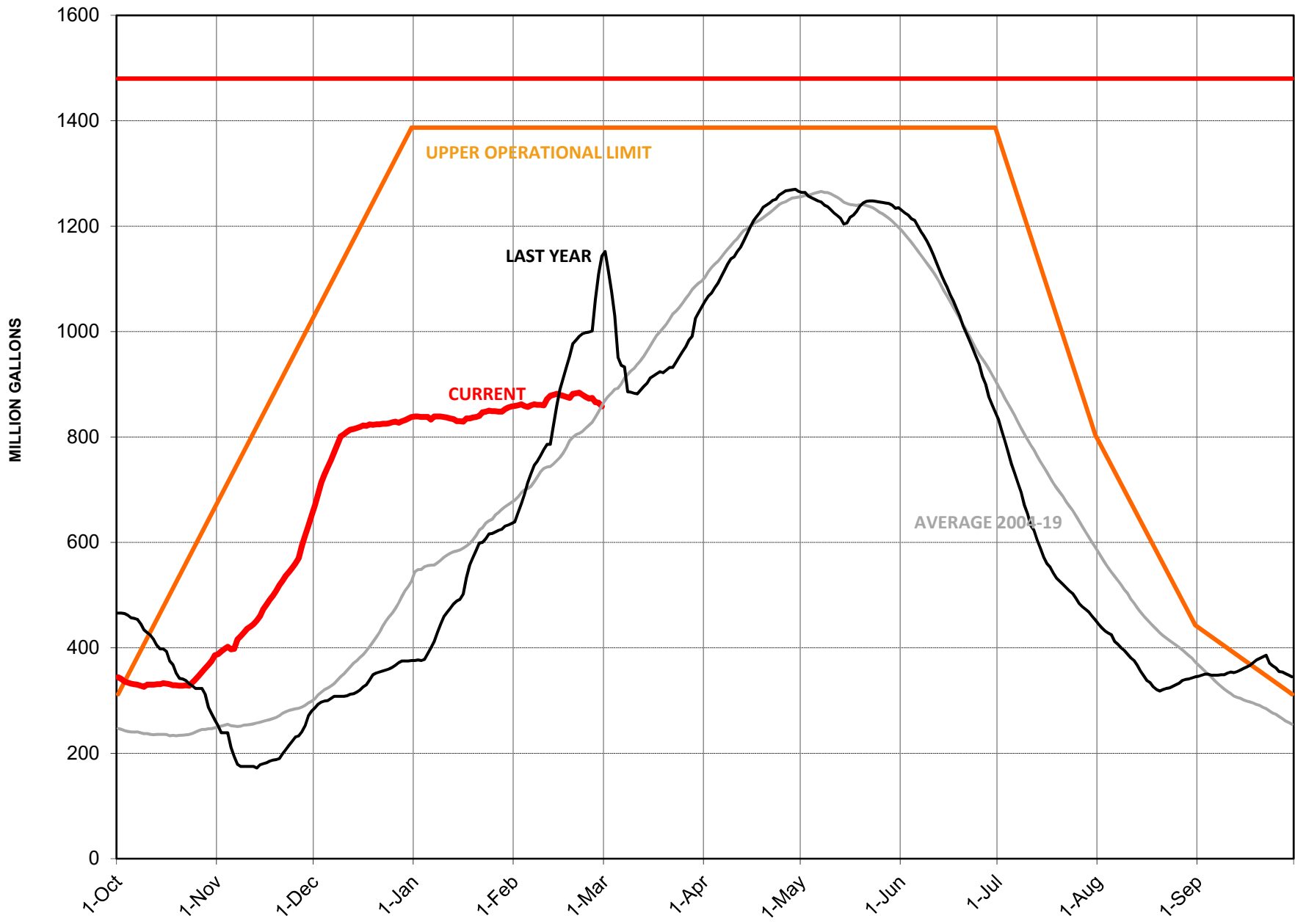

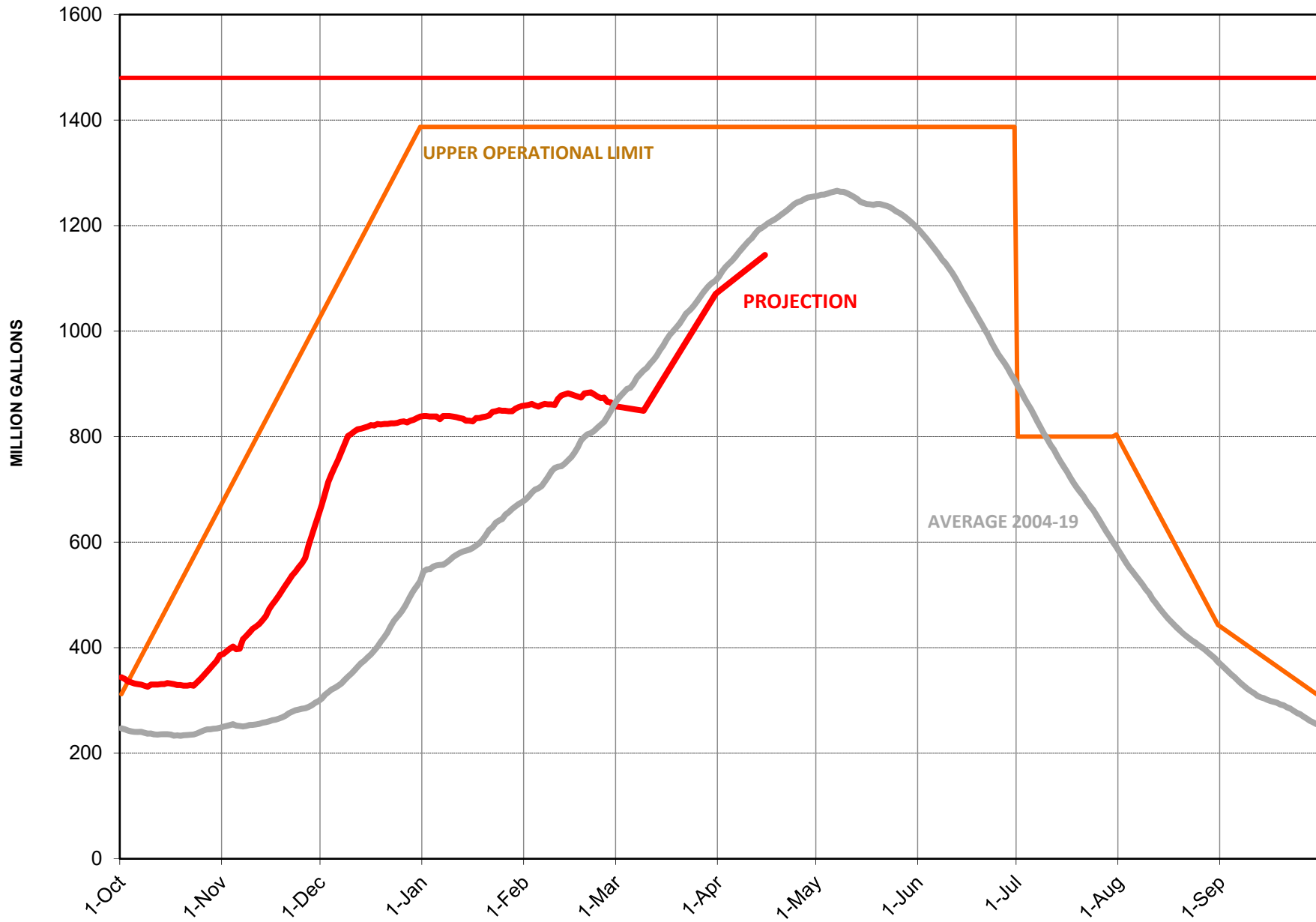
