



# Approval of Agreement with Axon Enterprise Inc. to Renew Contracts and Purchase Fleet Cameras

# BACKGROUND

- Santa Rosa Police Department has three separate contracts with Axon Enterprise Inc. (Axon) for equipment currently:
  - Body Worn Cameras contract approved with Axon in 2017 that is due for renewal
  - Interview room cameras contract approved in 2021 with Axon
  - Tasers contract approved in 2019 with Axon

# BACKGROUND

- Santa Rosa Police Department has no fleet cameras for their marked patrol vehicles
- Fleet cameras are the next phase of the Body Worn Camera programs that provide increased Officer and community safety
- Axon offers a significant cost savings by bundling all current contracts and adding fleet cameras

# PROPOSED

- The Santa Rosa Police Department wishes to consolidate current contracts with Axon Enterprise Inc. into one five year bundled agreement to reduce costs
- Fleet cameras will be added to the bundle

# BENEFIT

- Axon “Officer Safety Plan” bundled contract will reduce overall costs and provide integration of all technology and one source for all video evidence
- Five year contract includes warranties, tech support and reliable service
- Fleet cameras provide added security and increased transparency

# RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Police Department that the Council, by resolution: 1) approve a consolidated Professional Services Agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc., Scottsdale, Arizona, for the purchase and deployment of body-worn cameras, interview room cameras, fleet cameras, taser equipment and applicable software licensing, digital evidence management and storage for a five-year period in an amount not to exceed \$3,870,284.75; and 2) delegate authority to the Chief of Police, or designee, to negotiate and execute the final consolidated Agreement.
