

Public Hearing: Walnut Court Petition for Addition to Talbot Area Residential Permit Parking Zone

CURRENT

- Walnut Court currently has time limited parking of 2 hours, Mondays-Fridays 9AM-4PM
- Walnut Court does not currently have a residential permit program
- City Code Section 11-44.050 establishes process for designation of a permit zone

PROPOSED

- A petition has been received from residents of Walnut Court to be included in the Talbot area Residential Permit Parking Zone
- Residents may purchase permits exempting them from time limits

TALBOT AREA RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE



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BENEFIT

- Approval of this item will provide relief to residents, allowing them to park beyond posted time limits in the permit zone.
- The two-hour time limit will serve as a deterrent to long term spill over parking, freeing up parking spaces for residents.

RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Finance Department that Council, by resolution, approve the Walnut Court petition to be included in the Talbot area Residential Permit Parking Program.
