## Official - Third Driest Water Year on Record

- Oct 2019 – Sept 2020

## 38.76 inches of rain at Ukiah

- 48% of average

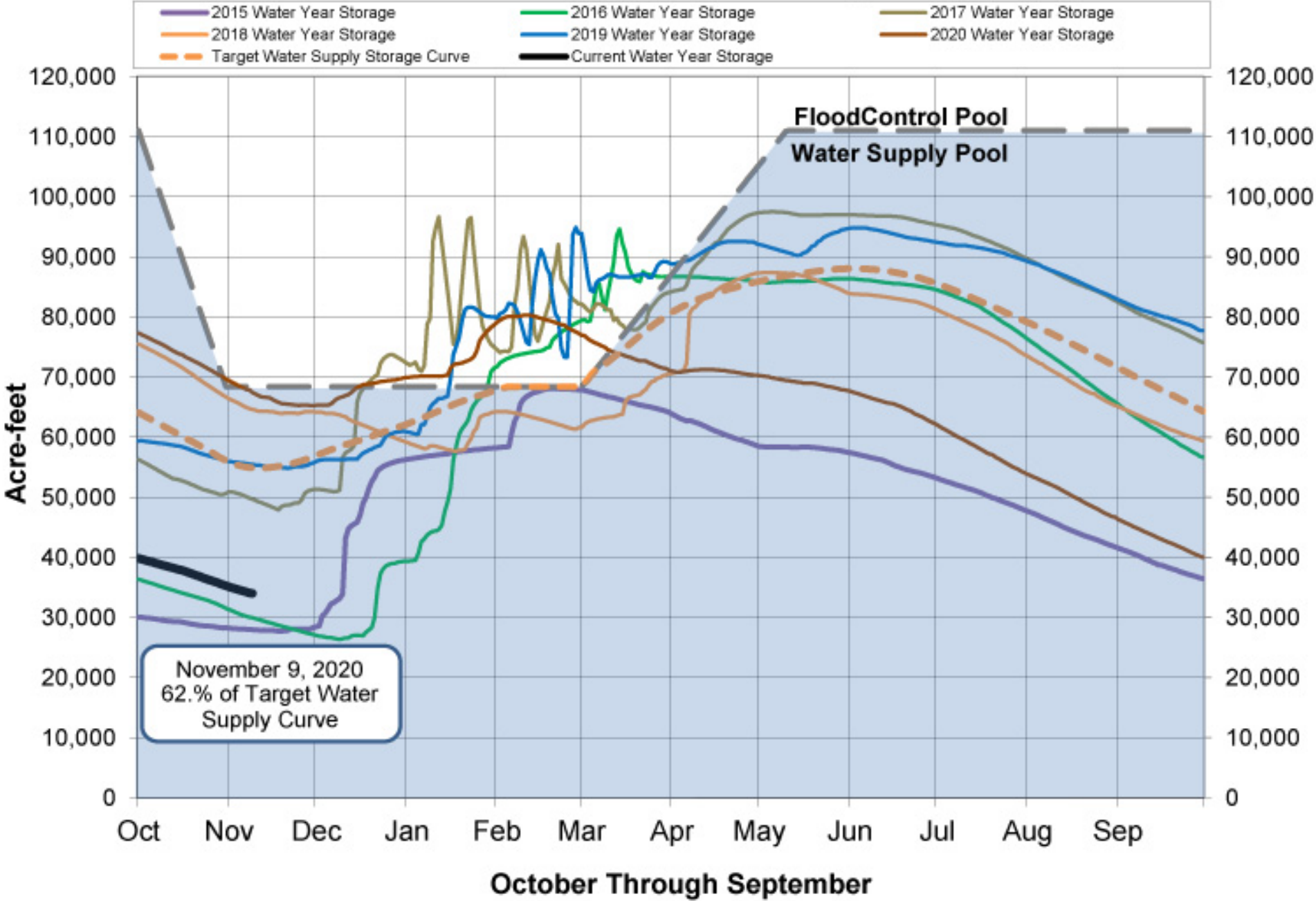
## 1976 – 1977 (Record Low)

- 14.20 inches

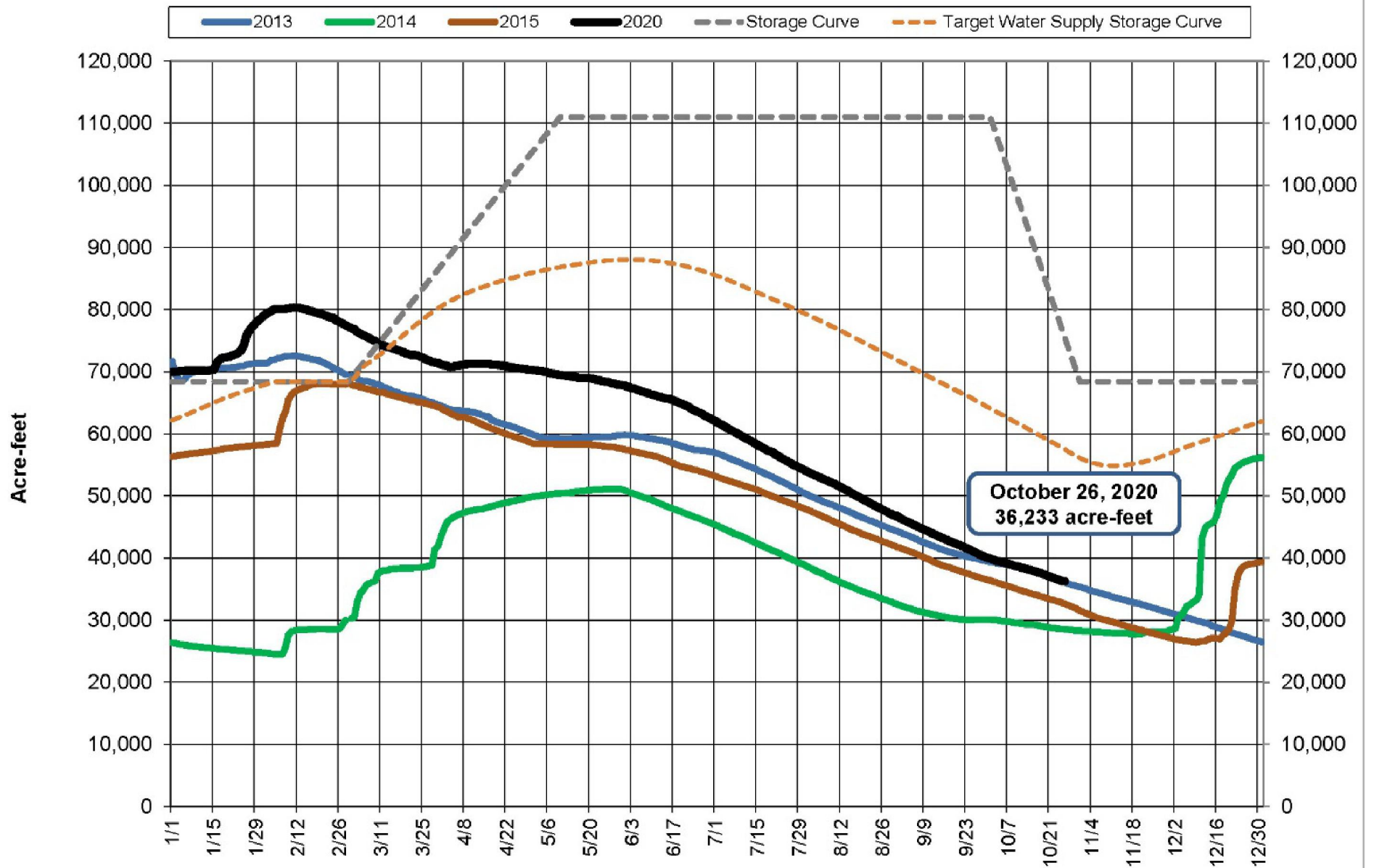

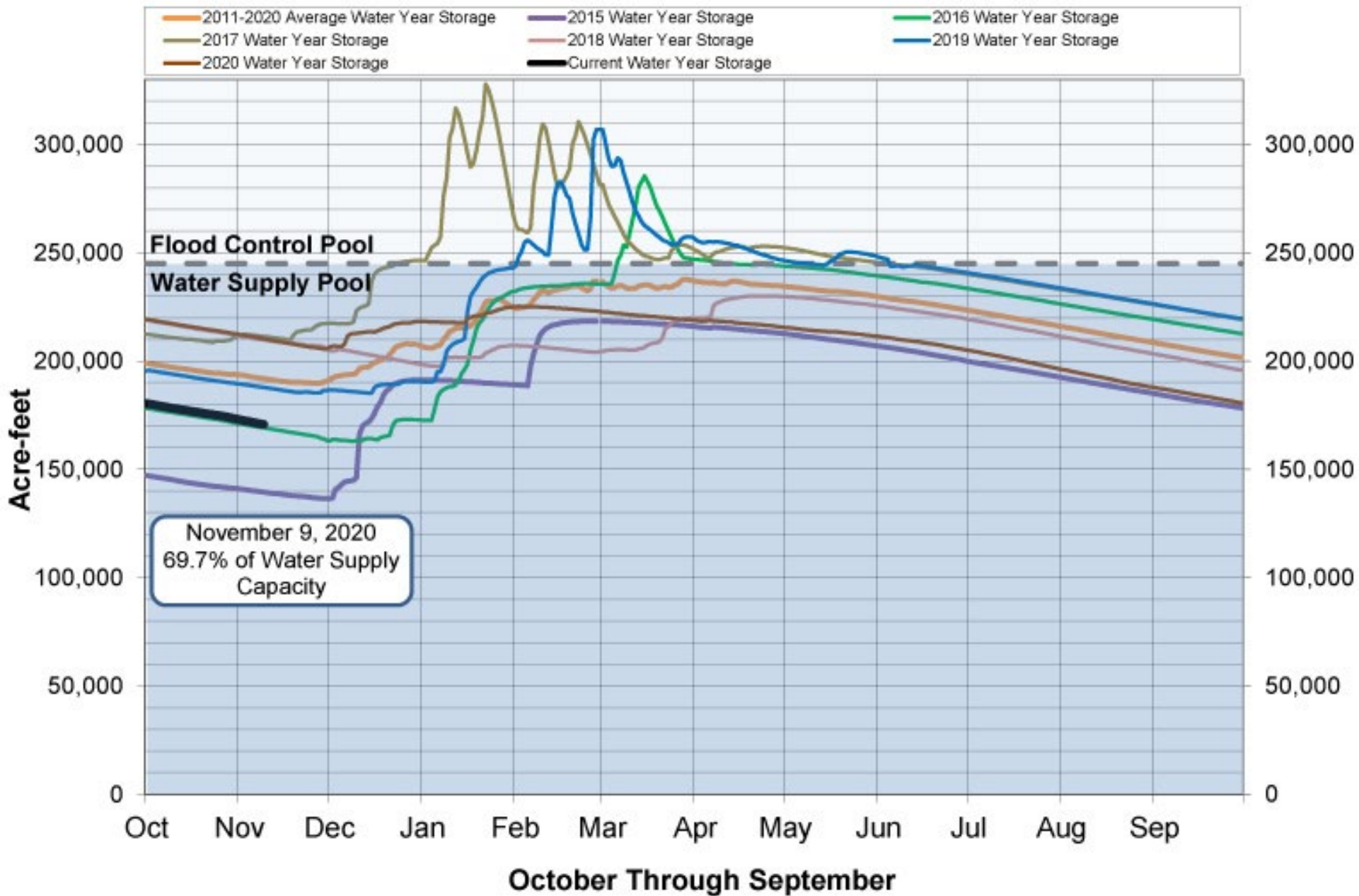
# Lake Mendocino Storage



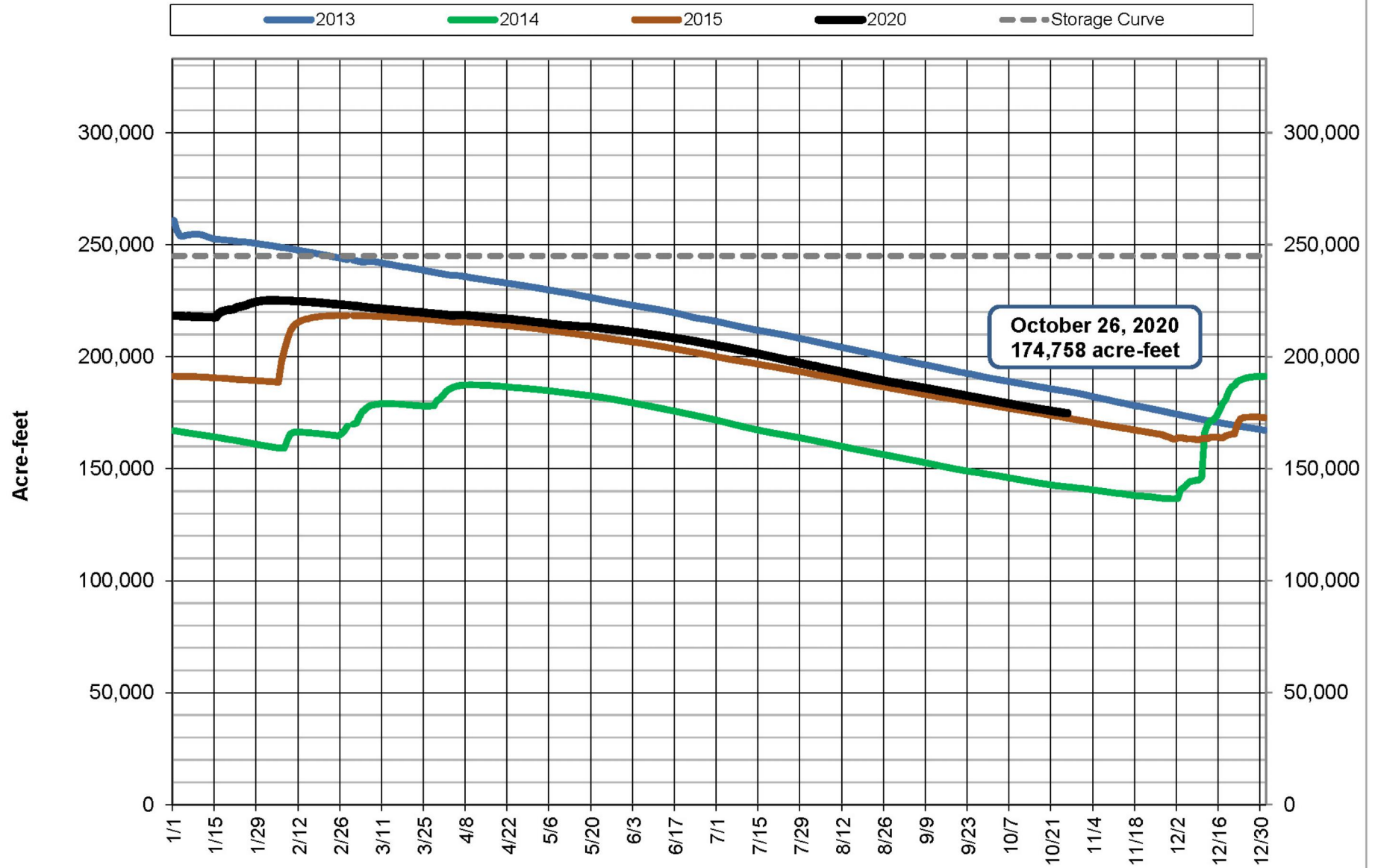
# Lake Mendocino Storage - Drought Years

## Sonoma Marin Water Saving Partnership

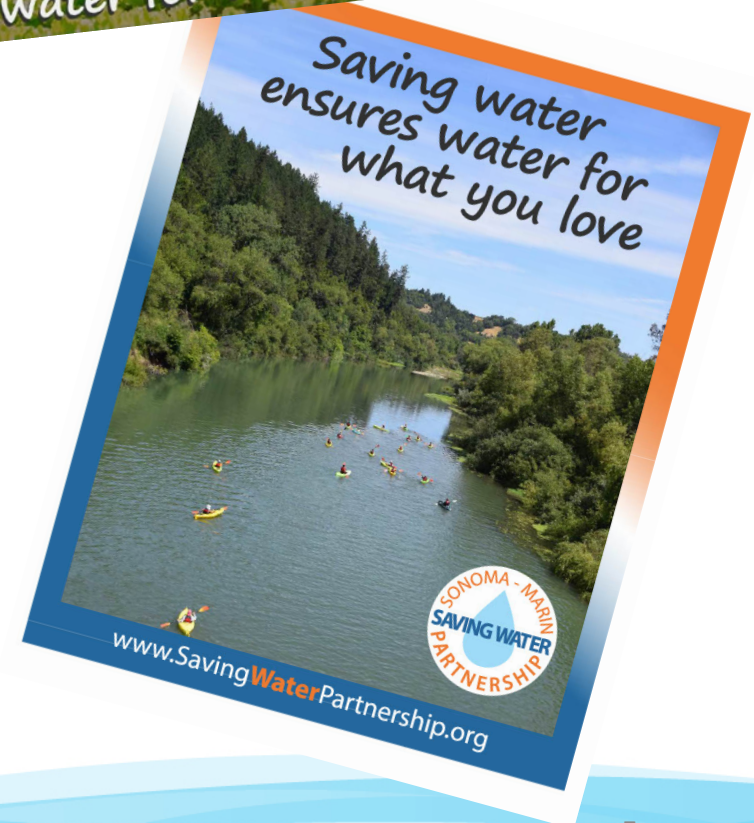
- Coordinating closely with other water contractors on dry conditions

- 75 rebates issued
  - 20,000 sq ft of turf replacement
  - 40 clothes washers
- 186 WaterSmart Surveys
