







Lake Pillsbury Storage





Lake Mendocino Storage








Recycled Water Storage

Ag Allotment Update

- 900 MG allotment in January (~53%)
- Increased additional 50MG in April, 2022
- Increased additional 200MG in July, 2022
- Increased additional 100MG in August, 2022
- Total allotment for 2022 is 1.25BG
 - No further increases in 2022
