

Third Amendment – General Services Agreement F001636 – Ammunition Disposal for Police Department

CURRENT

- Ammunition disposal services are currently being provided under this Agreement as awarded by the Purchasing Agent on March 27, 2018, to Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., Norwell, Massachusetts.
- This is the final extension option of the Agreement.

PROPOSED

- Extend the Agreement for one year with a 12% increase in unit cost.
- Increase compensation by \$40,000 for a total not to exceed amount of \$125,000.

BENEFIT

 Continued packaging, loading, transportation, and proper disposal of ammunition accumulated by the Police Department to an approved disposal facility.



RECOMMENDATION

 It is recommended by the Police and Finance Departments that the City Council approve the Third Amendment to extend the Agreement for an additional one-year period with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., Norwell, Massachusetts, and increase compensation in the amount of \$40,000, for a total cumulative amount not to exceed \$125,000.
