Warming Center Activation

- December 2021 & February 2022
- Extreme cold weather conditions
- Homeless Services Center
- 8pm to 7am
- Tents & Heaters
- 6 days total over 2 events
- 183 individuals served

Extreme Weather Warming Center Policy

- City Manager may direct activation of Warming Center based on Extreme Weather Event
- National Weather Service (“NWS”) forecasts:
 - Three (3) consecutive days with overnight lows below 32 degrees Fahrenheit.
 - Three (3) consecutive nights of rainfall with major or extreme risk levels as determined by the NWS.

First Amendment

- \$202,000 existing budget + \$45,000 Warming Center
- Approx. cost/activation - \$15,000
- 2 recent activations + contingency for potential activation in FY 21/22
- Future activations based on policy

Recommendation

It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Council, by resolution, approve a First Amendment to Grant Agreement for Public Service Providers Program Funds Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Santa Rosa CFDA #14.218 (First Amendment), increasing the contract by \$45,000 for a total amount of \$247,000, for the activation of a Warming Center at the Homeless Services Center in response to extreme weather conditions.
