


#### SURVEY RESULTS | Please select your age range.




#### **SURVEY RESULTS** | Where in the City do you live?


#### SURVEY RESULTS | What is the primary reason you visit South Davis Park?


WOULD YOU PREFER TO SEE THE EXISTING STEEL FENCE REPLACED WITH A SOLID CONCRETE BLOCK WALL?












#### WHICH CLIMBER IS YOUR FAVORITE?

### Recommendation

It is recommended by the Department of Transportation and Public Works, Parks Division that the Board of Community Services approve the South Davis Neighborhood Park Master Plan Amendment to include a revised playground area, picnic tables and barbeque areas, game tables, walking paths, updated sidewalks, a renovated basketball half-court, security lighting, fitness stations, native planting areas, and space for future activities, and recommend to Council approval of the same.
