ISSUE(S)

Should the City Council approve an agreement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company in the amount of \$6,810.20 to install a traffic controller service point for a new pedestrian crossing flasher on College Avenue at Glenn Street associated with the Safe Routes to School project?



COUNCIL GOALS AND STRATEGIES

This project relates to the following Council Goals and Strategies:

Goal 3: Provide Leadership in Environmental Initiatives

Strategic Objective 6, Improve our transportation system to reduce vehicle miles and promote multi-modal transportation.

BACKGROUND

1. On May 21, 2013, the City Council awarded construction contract No. C01579 to FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. for the Safe Routes to School – College Ave and Glenn St, West Ave and Delpport Ave, and Kawana Springs Rd and Meadow Way.
2. This Safe Routes to School project will install a pedestrian actuated flasher at the intersection of College Avenue and Glenn Street where there is a high volume of pedestrian activity within a quarter mile of two high schools and a middle school.

ANALYSIS

1. The traffic signal service point is needed for the operation of the pedestrian crossing flasher.
2. The City Attorney has reviewed the agreement.
3. The service point fee is fair and reasonable.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, approve the Traffic Controller Service Point Agreement for \$6,810.20 and authorize the Director of the Transportation and Public Works Department to execute the agreement-Contract ID: 1153166: College Avenue.
