14.1 REPORT - APPROVAL OF THE PRELIMINARY 2020/21 REGIONAL WATER REUSE SYSTEM OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT, AND DEBT SERVICE BUDGET AND ALLOCATION OF COSTS

BACKGROUND: The Regional Water Reuse System, managed by the

City of Santa Rosa per Agreement, is a state-of-the-art wastewater treatment facility serving five member agencies (Santa Rosa, Rohnert Park, Sebastopol, Cotati, and the Sonoma County South Park Sanitation District, each hereinafter referred to as "User Agency" or collectively as "User Agencies"). The Agreement requires that the City annually prepare a Preliminary Budget and Allocation of Costs for the Regional Water Reuse System and notify the User Agencies of these costs by May of each year. The Agreement further requires that the proposed budget and allocation of costs be reviewed by the Regional Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), the Board of Public Utilities (BPU) and the Council of the City of Santa Rosa prior to noticing the User Agencies of operating and debt service costs due.

The Regional Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Fund budget request is \$31,075,462 the Regional cash-funded Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is \$7,000,000 and the Regional debt service due is \$22,514,346.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended by the Water Department, the Regional Water Reuse System Technical Advisory Committee and the Board of Public Utilities that the Council, by resolution, approve the Preliminary 2020/21 Regional Water Reuse System Operating and Maintenance, Capital Improvement, and Debt Service Budget and Allocation of Costs for the purpose of notifying the participating Regional Water Reuse User Agencies of their allocation of such costs by May, 2020.
