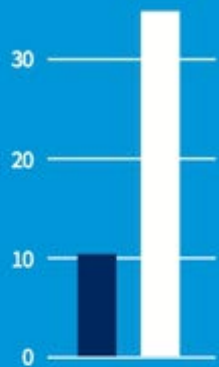


## SANTA ROSA RAINFALL

**36"**

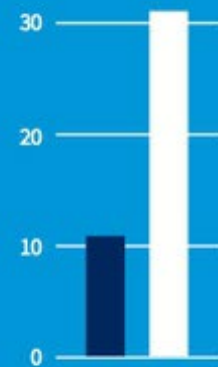


## UKIAH RAINFALL

**37"**



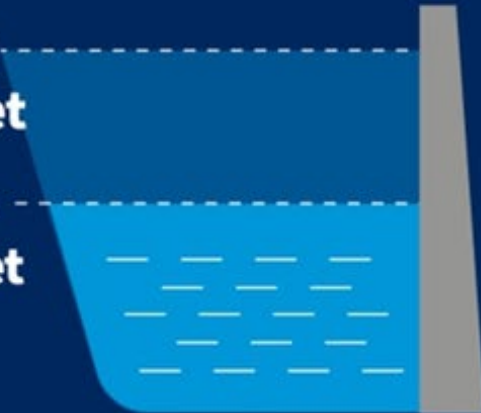
## LAKE SONOMA

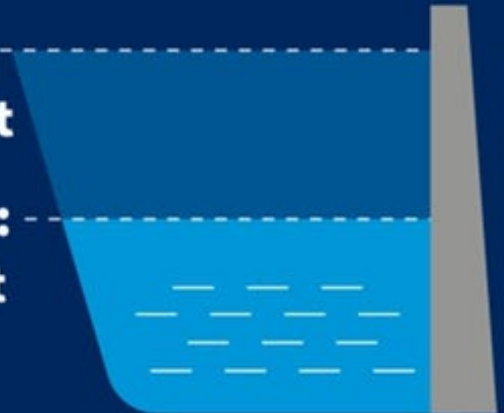
## LAKE MENDOCINO

# Water Supply Outlook

Without additional rainfall likely this year will be the driest water year on record (previously 1976-1977).

Sonoma Water's two reservoirs are at their lowest levels *for this time of year* in history of operation.

State approved Sonoma Water lowering flows in upper Russian River; additional request to the State coming; projections show additional water conservation is necessary
