WHEREAS, the long-range goal of The Partnership is to create a unified and continuous service delivery system of shared accountability that streamlines all local youth and gang violence awareness, prevention, intervention, and reentry efforts, thus creating a public health model aimed at supporting Santa Rosa youth and families; and

WHEREAS, The Partnership is working to implement a well-coordinated continuum of services through the fundamental pillars: Invest, Lead, and Educate, aimed at building resiliency in youth and keeping Santa Rosa families safe and engaged at schools, community centers, parks, and throughout our neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, The Partnership continuously enhances its community outreach and awareness strategies of informing and educating the public about The Partnership's efforts, impact, and outcomes aimed at preventing youth and gang violence; and

WHEREAS, The Partnership has served over 30,000 youth and families through Measure O funding since 2004 by aligning and mobilizing partners such as the Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Sonoma County, California Youth Outreach, Community Action Partnership, Social Advocates for Youth, and various organizations and initiatives that align with the mission, vision, and values of The Partnership.
