

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2024-146

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE - BYRNE DISCRETIONARY COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$898,000; AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS; APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$898,000; AND AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO ESTABLISH A PROJECT KEY

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance-Byrne Discretionary Community Project invited the Santa Rosa Police Department to apply for funds to establish the Santa Rosa Police Department's Real Time Crime Center; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance-Byrne Discretionary Community Project has awarded the Santa Rosa Police Department a grant in the amount of \$898,000, for the Santa Rosa Police Department to establish a Real Time Crime Center; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds will enable the Santa Rosa Police Department to create a Real Time Crime Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa accepts a grant award from the Bureau of Justice Assistance-Byrne Discretionary Community Project in the amount of \$898,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council appropriates funds in the amount of \$898,000, the source of funds being a grant award from the Bureau of Justice Assistance-Byrne Discretionary Community Project into a project key to be established by the Chief Financial Officer.
