



Declaration of Results for the General Municipal Election November 8, 2022

CURRENT

- The November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election was held pursuant to the City of Santa Rosa Charter Section 30.
- Sonoma County Registrar of Voters has canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results.

PROPOSED

- Following completion of the canvass of votes and before installing the new officers, the City Council must adopt a resolution declaring election results for Council Districts 2, 3, 4, and 6 and for City Measure H, Measure I, and Measure J.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the City Clerk that the Council:
1) by resolution, recite the fact and declare the results of the Consolidated General Municipal Election held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the election to the City Council of Mark Stapp for District 2, Victoria Fleming for District 4, Jeff Okrepkie for District 6, each for a full term of four years, and Dianna MacDonald for District 3 for a term of two years and the approval of City of Santa Rosa Measure H - City of Santa Rosa Funding for Public Safety, Measure I – City of Santa Rosa City Charter Amendment – District – Based Election of Council Members, Measure J – City of Santa Rosa City Charter Update and Modernization; and

Recommendation (cont.)

- 2) adopt an Ordinance amending Chapter 3-26 of the Santa Rosa City Code to extend a quarter-cent transaction and use tax to fund public safety and violence prevention programs and to update permissible uses of the tax revenues.
