
# Roseland Area Projects

#### Annexation

- √ 5 County islands (712 acres)
- ✓ Currently reviewing the cost and revenue estimates

#### Specific Plan

- √ 1,860 acres: 1,220 incorporated, 640 unincorporated
- ✓ Comprehensively address land use and transportation issues, assess infrastructure, concurrent rezoning and prezoning, and EIR

 Strict application of Council Policy 000-06 is not appropriate for the development of this unique committee



#### Recommendation

It is recommended by the Community Development Department that the Council, by motion:

- Waive Council Policy 000-06 regarding appointments to Boards/Commissions/Committees, and
- Confirm the initial Steering Committee Member list for the Roseland Area/Sebastopol Road Specific Plan and Roseland Area Annexation projects, allowing for the addition of new members as needed throughout the process.
