**RE: SB 55 (Umberg) Vehicles: catalytic converters (As Amended 4/10/23)**

The proposed bill would assist law enforcement in catching and identifying individuals in possession of dozens, or even hundreds, of suspect catalytic converters. Unfortunately, at the current time, law enforcement investigators often have challenges to prove that a catalytic converter was stolen.

This bill would remedy the situation by requiring that car dealers apply the vehicle identification number (VIN) to the catalytic converter of each vehicle listed for sale. This will enhance the ability of law enforcement agencies to track stolen catalytic converters, and identify which vehicles they were stolen from.

In terms of local data, Santa Rosa residents reported the following catalytic converter thefts:

- 2020 – 150
- 2021 – 368
- 2022 – 143

Thank you for your leadership on this important public safety matter. The City of Santa Rosa is pleased to support this measure, as reflected by the Council's unanimous vote on May 9, 2023 to support SB 55.
