CHOICE Mini-Grant Program

- Provides schools and non-profit organizations with one-time funds for programs that align with the Violence Prevention Partnership's strategic mission.
- Maximum grant award is \$5,000 per program/project per fiscal year.
- Review Committee includes a minimum of one Policy Team member and two staff members.

CHOICE Mini-Grant Program

- To establish contractual timelines for grant fund expenditure and performance measure reporting, a formal funding agreement is necessary.
- Due to the low grant award maximum amount, authorization to approve and execute is requested for the Director of the Office of Community Engagement.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Office of Community Engagement that the Council, by resolution, authorize the Director of the Office of Community Engagement, or designee, to approve and execute funding agreements for Measure O Community Helping Our Indispensable Children Excel (CHOICE) Mini-Grant Program in amounts not to exceed \$5,000 per Program/Project each fiscal year.
