EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As part of the agreement that Bedford Lodging reached with Local 2850 (WHO) for the development of the AC Marriott Hotel in Railroad Square, Bedford Lodging is donating \$10,000 to the City of Santa Rosa's affordable housing program.

BACKGROUND

As part of the negotiations between Bedford Lodging and Local 2850 – Hotel, Foodservices and Gaming Workers' Union, a donation of \$10,000 is being made to the City of Santa Rosa's affordable housing programs. The funds are being incorporated into the Housing Trust production budget for use during fiscal year 2019/20.
