



# Appropriation of Funding from PG&E Settlement Funds to Two of the Seven Highest Priority Projects

# CURRENT

- Staff presented four study sessions for the use of the PG&E settlement funds.
- The Fire Department identified two of the seven highest priority projects that are ready to begin pending funding availability.

# PROPOSED

- Appropriate funding into two separate project accounts; JL key 05109 in the amount of \$5,250,000 for the implementation of a comprehensive vegetation management program and JL key 05110 in the amount of \$2,750,000 for the implementation of a Wildland Resiliency and Response Strategic Plan.

# RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Fire Department that Council, by resolution, authorize the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate the funds previously approved for the Fire Department from the PG&E settlement into two separate project accounts. One project in the amount of \$5,250,000 is to be allocated for the implementation of a comprehensive Vegetation Management Program and the second project in the amount of \$2,750,000 is to be allocated for the implementation of a Wildland Resiliency and Response strategic plan. Both projects are among the top seven highest priority projects related to wildfire preparedness, mitigation and resiliency.
