



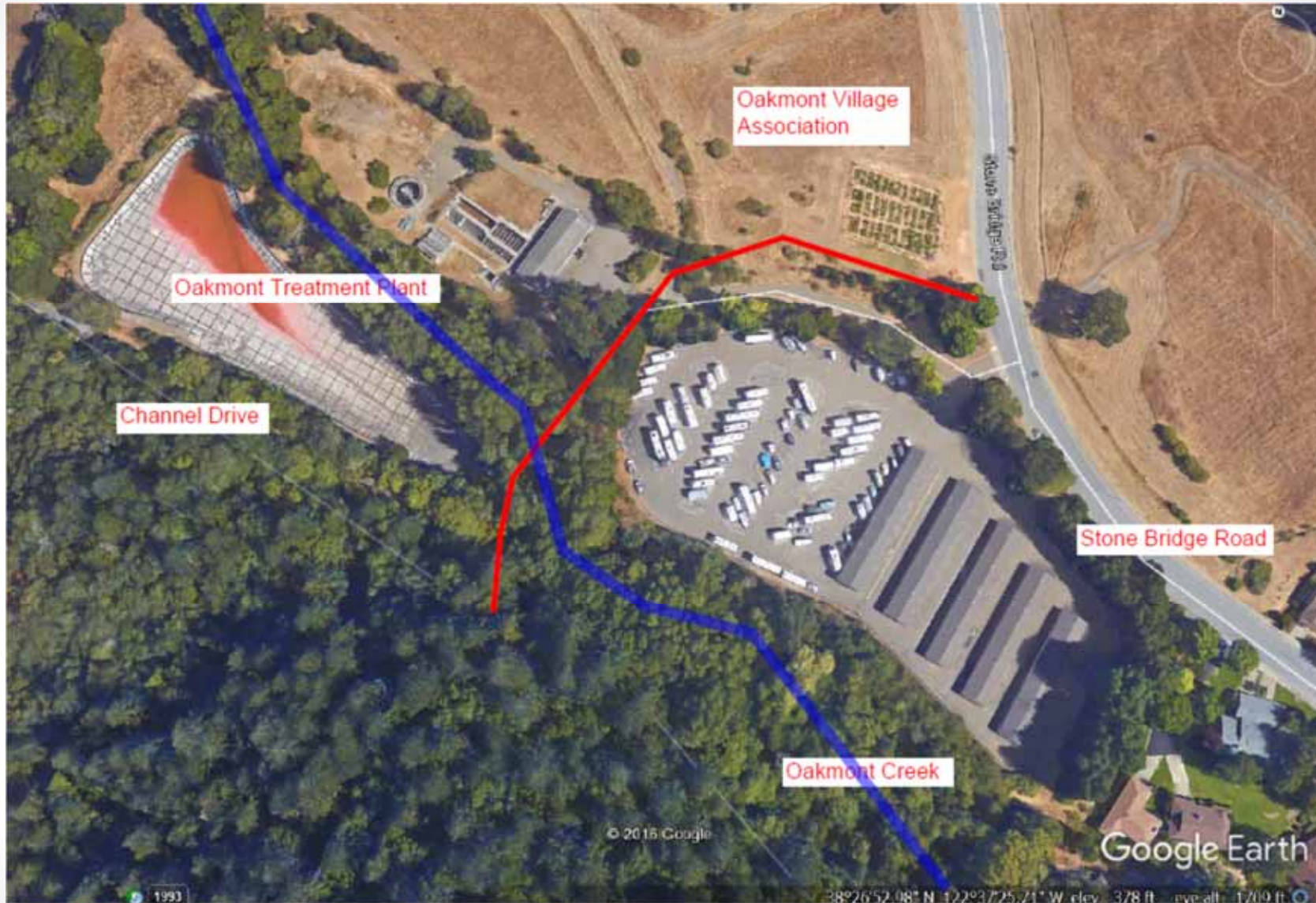
Designation of a Recreational Trail Across the Oakmont Treatment Plant Property

BACKGROUND

- Currently no designated general public access
- Existing service road for Santa Rosa Water
- Multiple requests to formalize public access
- RV Park owner no longer wants general public to cross his property



ANALYSIS

- The Oakmont Village Association path solution
- Staff conducted ADA review
- Concern about continuing public access between Channel Drive and Stone Bridge Road
- Oakmont Village Association open to discussing a public access easement between treatment plant and Stone Bridge Road

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation & Public Works and Santa Rosa Water Departments, that the Council, by resolution, designate a recreational trail across the Oakmont Treatment Plant property and direct staff to discuss the acquisition of a public bicycle and pedestrian easement from the Oakmont Village Association over their property immediately to the east to provide continuous public access between Channel Drive and Stone Bridge Road.
