CalVIP Grant Award

- Received from the Board of State & Community Corrections for grant term of September 2018 through August 2020
- Enhances gang prevention and intervention efforts
- Continues wraparound case management through the Guiding People Successfully (GPS) Multi-Disciplinary Assessment and Referral Team (MDART)
- Additional sub-granted funds for program evaluation of grant funds to community-based organizations for direct services to youth

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Office of Community Engagement that the Council, by resolution, approve the First Amendment to Professional Services Agreement F001773 with LPC Consulting Associates, Inc. for CalVIP grantee evaluation services, increasing compensation by \$50,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$150,000.
