### RFP SUMMARY

- RFP issued May 14; due May 27, 2020
- Sixty (60) vouchers available
- Intent of RFP to make projects more competitive for upcoming funding competition at the State level
- Final award of vouchers will be contingent upon the project receiving the competitive funding the PBVs are being used to leverage

- 136 units
- Community spaces, after school program, health and wellness program

## RECOMMENDED PROJECTS – 2 of 3

#### **Burbank Avenue Apartments**

- Developer: Waterstone Residential, LLC
- Twelve (12) Project-Based Vouchers
- 64 units
- Part of larger (138 unit) mixed income Subdivision of single family, townhomes and multifamily dwellings
- Active and passive outdoor amenities, children's play area, greenspace

- Developer: Burbank Housing Devel. Corp.
- Thirty (30) Project-Based Vouchers
- 64 units

- Twelve (12) vouchers to Waterstone Residential, LLC for Burbank Avenue Apartments located at 1400 Burbank Ave and 1780 Burbank Avenue; and
- Thirty (30) vouchers to Burbank Housing Development Corporation for Caritas Homes Phase I, located at Morgan Street and Seventh Street
