Background

Fully modernized the Police Radio system making it more reliable with expanded geographic coverage

- December 18, 2018: Council approved funding for Phase 1
 - Completed in 2019 significantly modernizing the computer backbone and dispatch consoles.
- December 10, 2019: Council approved funding for Phase 2
 - Completed earlier this year and included upgrading the tower equipment as well as the field deployed radios.

Proposed

- Enter into a Maintenance and software system upgrade agreement for the radio system
- Nine-year term
- Will include product repair, obsolescent hardware replacement, network monitoring, preventive maintenance, and operating system security patches, including the tower equipment

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance and Police Departments that the Council, by resolution, approve and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney, an Amendment/ Change Order No. 3 to the Communications System and Services Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. of San Diego, CA increasing the compensation by \$2,755,731.11 for a total not to exceed amount of \$8,104,319.80 covering nine years of maintenance and software system upgrades.
