CURRENT

- State Transit Assistance (STA) funding from the State of Good Repair (SGR) account authorized under SB1 (2017) is generated from a portion of a new transportation improvement fee on vehicle registration
- The SGR program goal is to provide funding to rehabilitate and modernize California's existing local transit systems

PROPOSED

- Request \$25,473 in SGR funds that Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department will use to maintain and repair the fixed-route fleet of buses.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the project list for preventative maintenance, and authorize the Director of Transportation and Public Works or his designee to request the City's allocated Fiscal Year 2020-21 State of Good Repair (SGR) funding in the amount of \$25,473 from the California Department of Transportation.
