



Approval of Maintenance Agreement for Retaining Walls/Barriers in the City of Santa Rosa

BACKGROUND

- The City and State have numerous Freeway Maintenance Agreements.
- In 2010, the State widened Highway 101 from four lanes to six within the City between PM 22.1 and PM 23.7, and constructed several retaining walls.
- This agreement clarifies maintenance responsibilities for the modifications at Bicentennial Way & Mendocino Avenue.

ANALYSIS

- Two existing agreements from 1964 and 1989 outline current maintenance responsibilities at these two crossings.
- A supplemental agreement was drafted to update the division of responsibility between the State and City for modifications created by the project.
- This agreement is not meant to replace or supersede the earlier agreements.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department, that the Council, by resolution, approve the maintenance agreement for retaining walls/barriers in the City of Santa Rosa, with the State of California relating to Bicentennial Avenue and Mendocino Avenue interchanges with State Route 101.
