- ✓ Each year, City Council provides CAB funding for the Community Improvement Grant Program
- ✓ Goal of the program:
 - ✓ Support community building
 - ✓ Improves neighborhoods
 - ✓ Strengthens City relationships with the community
 - ✓ Funds Neighborfest (currently suspended)
- ✓ Community Groups can apply for up to \$2,500
 - ✓ Includes neighborhood or community groups (formal or informal), schools, non-profits, and service services clubs
