



# Contract Award – Fire Damaged Street Lights Replacement in Coffey Park

# BACKGROUND

- This project will replace 229 street lights damaged during the Tubbs in the Coffey Park area. The scope of work includes installing about 2.5 miles of electrical conduit mostly in the street. About 120 locations will be upgraded with new foundations and pull boxes to meet current city standards.

# ANALYSIS

- The project was advertised on October 3, 2019, and bids were received on November 7, 2019. A total of two (2) bids were received, ranging from \$1,791,512.80 to \$1,988,830.00.
- The low bid was 10.48% over the Engineer's estimate.
- Construction is anticipated to begin approximately January 2020. The length of the contract is 80 working days.

# RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by motion, award Contract No. C02233, Fire Damaged Street Lights Replacement in Coffey Park, in the amount of \$1,791,512.80 to the lowest responsible bidder, St. Francis Electric of San Leandro, California, approve a 15% contract contingency, and authorize a total contract amount of \$2,060,239.72.
