# Fee Adjustments

- Fee increases ranging from 2.47 – 7.69%
- 28 fees requiring City Council approval
- Total fee adjustments estimated to generate \$5,454 revenue
- Increases from:
  - Impound & Boarding Fees
  - Kennel & Pet Shop Licenses
  - Other fees
