

Hello City Council Members,

I'm writing regarding the question of establishing a right for voucher holders to have access to vacancies in Santa Rosa. I know this is tough question, because many landlords do not wish to accept vouchers, especially during this time of very low vacancies. I recognize that Council members may be concerned about creating a new requirement for private sector owners. But I urge you to consider the distress for low income people, who have waited years for this opportunity, to lose their access to housing because no one will rent to them. Another helpful approach, which Santa Rosa, may already be doing, is to be proactive in connecting voucher holders with opportunities and to provide landlords with a designated contact staff person. In any case, I hope you will consider the scarcity of housing available to very low income people in making your decision on this question.

I had hoped to make my comments at tomorrow's meeting, but a family obligation prevents me from attending. - John Lowry
