RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Police Department that the Council, by resolution, approve the inter-agency operations agreement with the Sonoma County Junior College District for dispatch services during designated hours when the District's dispatch center closes; and authorize the Chief of Police to execute the agreement.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Sonoma County Junior College District Police Department's staffing levels do not always allow for operations during the graveyard shift hours. The City of Santa Rosa dispatch center is staffed for 24-hour operation on a daily basis. This inter-agency agreement will allow the City of Santa Rosa dispatch center to dispatch the District police as needed. This is anticipated to have a negligible impact on staff.

BACKGROUND

The Police Department works closely with the other public safety departments throughout the County, including the Sonoma County Junior College District. It is important to continue to assist smaller agencies as necessary to better serve the entire community.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Staff have reviewed the call volume of the Sonoma County Junior College District and determined that these additional calls will have a negligible impact on the dispatch staff. The dispatch services will only be provided to the District as needed, when their staffing levels do not allow for operations to continue during graveyard shift hours.
