#### ISSUE(S)

Should the City Council adopt a resolution establishing fees for various Recreation & Parks facilities and services?



### COUNCIL GOALS AND STRATEGIES

Goal 4: "Maintain and Enhance our City's Cultural and Recreational Assets (facilities, program, parks, etc.)."

#### BACKGROUND

- 1. The Recreation & Parks Department offers a wide variety of services for which fees are charged, including facility use, admissions and program fees. Fees are charged to recover the direct costs of providing these facilities and services.
- 2. City Code Section 11-46.030 requires Council to establish park user fees by resolution. Park user fees include facility rental and admission fees.
- 3. Council previously adopted fees for Recreation & Parks' facilities, programs and services; the actions are summarized as follows:
  - a. In 1995, Council approved Resolution 22307, a list of facility rental fees, amusement activities and associated services. Council also delegated authority to the Director of Recreation & Parks to set the necessary fees for seasonal program activities, excursions, special events, and athletic league-entry fees based on the City's actual costs for the activities.
  - b. In 2000, Council approved Resolution 24445, a comprehensive list of facility rental fees, park sites, amusement activities and associated services.

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- c. In 2010, Council approved Resolution 27648, an adjustment to facility rental rates, park special use permits, athletic fields and aquatic programming; and
- d. In 2012, Council approved Resolution 28032 eliminating the non-resident fee for picnic site reservations in order to assist Recreation & Parks with the administration of the picnic site program.
- 4. Due to the completion and opening of new facilities, including the Person Senior Wing, DeTurk Round Barn, and Church of One Tree, an update to the Department's fee list is needed. Attached is a master list of Recreation & Parks' Fees.

### **ANALYSIS**

- Adjustments to admissions and facility rental fees requires Council approval. Fees for all other programs and classes are adjusted by staff regularly, based on the cost of providing the services and programs. Another consideration in establishing fees is whether or not the demand for a program or service would continue if the fee were increased to cover more of the cost of providing it.
- 2. Past Department practices have waived fees for rental rooms for various nonprofit organizations and community-based groups. With the adoption of the proposed fee list, non-profit organizations will be charged a standard rate for room rentals.
- 3. Facility rentals are a lucrative way for Recreation & Parks to provide rooms for public rental when those rooms and stand alone facilities aren't programmed with recreation activities and events.
- 4. The Department is requesting that the Director of Recreation & Parks or designee be authorized to enter into facility rental permits and reduce the rental fees as needed to accommodate department business needs. Fee reductions may be applied to ongoing rentals, i.e. groups that rent a room(s) once a week for year or to allow event set-up if the room has not been rented by another party.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Department of Recreation & Parks that the Council, by resolution, approve the Facility Rental fees for various facilities and services effective July 1, 2013 and authorize the Director of Recreation & Parks or designee to enter into facility rental permits.
