RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Housing and Community Services Department that the Housing Authority elect a Chair and Vice-Chair to serve with a term of office commencing on February 27, 2023.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Each year, following City Council appointments to the Authority Board, the Authority, by motion, elects a Chair and Vice-Chair to serve for the remainder of the calendar year, and until a new Chair and Vice-Chair are elected.

BACKGROUND

- The Housing Authority Bylaws Section 2.04 entitled "Election of Officers" establishes the annual election of officers on the next Regular Meeting of the Authority following City Council appointments to the Housing Authority board for the new calendar year.
- 2. The City Council appointed three commissioners to the Housing Authority board at their February 14, 2023, Regular Meeting.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

As outlined in the Housing Authority Bylaws, the Authority shall elect a Chair and Vice Chair at the next regular meeting of the Authority following City Council appointments to the Housing Authority board for the new calendar year. Typically, City Council appointments occur between January and February each year. This year, City Council made appointments to the Housing Authority board at their February 14, 2023, meeting. The February 27, 2023, Housing Authority meeting is the first Regular Meeting of the Housing Authority following the City Council appointments.

The Bylaws state that the term of the Chair and Vice-Chair shall be one year or until their successors are elected, and allows for officers to serve consecutive terms, if so elected by the Authority.

PRIOR HOUSING AUTHORITY REVIEW

There is no fiscal impact to the Housing Authority's budget by this action.
