

RESOLUTION NO. RES-2019-033

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE PG&E FLEETREADY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa has received two competitive grant awards from the Federal Transit Administration's 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Program totaling \$2.9 million for the City's first four battery-electric buses and charging equipment; and

WHEREAS, the California Air Resources Board adopted the Innovative Clean Transit Rule in December 2018, requiring the conversion of transit fleets to zero-emissions buses by 2040; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa Transportation and Public Works Department has identified deficiencies in the electrical service and infrastructure necessary to charge heavy-duty electric vehicles at the Municipal Services Center; and

WHEREAS, PG&E is set to launch the FleetReady Program in Spring 2019 pending final California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) approval; and

WHEREAS, the FleetReady Program will support conversion of commercial and public fleets to electric by upgrading the grid and providing a "make-ready" connection to chargers for heavy duty fleets, as well as contribute up to 50% of the cost of vehicle chargers for transit agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the Director of Transportation and Public Works to take the necessary steps to apply to the PG&E FleetReady program for electric vehicle charging infrastructure.
