RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, delegate authority to the Directors of the Departments of Transportation and Public Works, and Water or their designees to approve and execute California Highway Patrol (CHP) standard forms and agreements for the Construction Zone Enhancement Enforcement Program (COZEEP).

BACKGROUND

- Critical due to Caltrans Encroachment Permit for Geotechnical Investigation on Hearn Avenue Interchange at US 101.
- California adopted the Construction Zone Enhanced Enforcement Program (COZEEP).
- Project safety through the use of supplemental California Highway Patrol (CHP) personnel.
- City would reimburse CHP for actual cost of their COZEEP services.
- City staff do not have the legal authority to approve or execute documents with the CHP.

ANALYSIS

- Delegate authority to approve and execute California Highway Patrol (CHP) standard forms and agreements for traffic control support when needed.
- Allow City staff to provide services to the community in an efficient manner.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that Council, by resolution, delegate authority to the Directors of the Departments of Transportation and Public Works, and Water or their designees to approve and execute California Highway Patrol (CHP) standard forms and agreements for the Construction Zone Enhancement Enforcement Program (COZEEP).
