The City of Santa Rosa Housing Authority (SRHA) has a robust, high-performing Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program that includes 365 Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (VASH) vouchers. Despite the positive relationships that SRHA has with over 700 landlords in our community, voucher holders struggle to find housing in an increasingly competitive rental market. Many property owners refuse to consider tenants holding Housing Choice Vouchers, trouncing upon the core value of the program to give low-income families the choice to find housing that best meets their needs.

Vouchers are not considered a protected source of income under FEHA; therefore, landlords may freely deny housing to otherwise qualified voucher holders. These practices, which occur in jurisdictions throughout the state, harm tenants, impair the ability of local Housing Authorities to perform their functions, and exacerbate the already severe housing crisis in California.

At least nine other states, including New Jersey, Oklahoma, and Oregon, have taken a stand for housing opportunity by clarifying that housing subsidies are a protected source of income. It is time for California to join their ranks.
