

APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-17

CURRENT

- Article XIIIB of the California Constitution requires local governments to adopt an annual Appropriations Limit
- Each local jurisdiction must establish its
 Appropriation Limit by resolution each year
- The Limit only applies to the proceed of taxes in the City's General Government type funds

PROPOSED

- Santa Rosa's calculated Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2016-17 is \$238,817,000
- Appropriations subject to the Limit are projected to be \$125,588,000
- Santa Rosa is not at risk of exceeding the calculated Appropriations Limit

RECOMMENDATION

• It is recommended by the Finance
Department that the Council, by resolution,
adopt the Article XIIIB Appropriation Limit at
\$238,817,000 for Fiscal Year 2016-17, and
approve the use of the inflation and
population factors used in the calculation of
the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Appropriations Limit.
