



PURCHASE ORDER FOR 2022 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR HYBRID SUVs

CURRENT

- The Transportation and Public Works and Police Department request sole manufacture purchase order for the purchase of 28 Ford Police Hybrid SUVs through the Fleet vehicle replacement program.
- On October 6, 2021 Invitation for Bid 21-48 was opened by Purchasing
- Two bid responses were received, only Napa Ford, Napa, CA was responsive and responsible to the bid solicitation.

PROPOSED

- Approve sole manufacture bid award and issuance of a Purchase Order for the purchase of twenty-eight (28) 2022 Ford Police Interceptor Hybrid SUVs to the lowest responsive bidder Napa Ford, Napa, CA for total not to exceed amount of \$1,246,355.42.

BENEFIT

- The Police Department has studied various sedans and SUV pursuit rated patrol vehicles, determining that the mid-size platform of the Ford Interceptor SUV provides the most applicable balance of size, function, and economy relative to the City of Santa Rosa's urban environment
- Additionally, the Ford Interceptor SUV base model is the only gasoline-hybrid powertrain currently available which provides a 32% reduction of gasoline used over each vehicle's life cycle.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works, Police and Finance Departments, that the Council, by resolution, approve a purchase order for the purchase of twenty-eight (28) 2022 Ford Police Interceptor Hybrid SUVs to Napa Ford, Napa, California, in an amount not to exceed \$1,246,355.42. Funds for this purchase are funded in Fiscal Year 2021-22 Transportation and Public Works Fleet Vehicle Replacement approved budget and does not have a fiscal impact on the General Fund.
