CURRENT

- The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) requires a resolution adopted by the governing board to be included in the grant application for the Transit Performance Initiative Program
- MTC policy sets aside a portion of the TPI funds for small transit operators in the Bay Area, including the City of Santa Rosa
- The City has a total of \$525,787 available in this program from funds programmed in FY 14-15

PROPOSED

- The TPI grant would cover \$525,787 of the cost of the implementation of the Reimagining CityBus service redesign with an in-kind match of City staff time
- The MTC grant process requires that the grant be submitted at this time with the funds to be available by the start of FY 17-18

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Transportation and Public Works Department that the Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager or designee to execute and file the grant application under the Transit Performance Initiative Program to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) for the “Support of the Implementation of Reimagining CityBus project”.
