RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE AND EXECUTE THE 2017 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO; AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-18 ADOPTED BUDGET TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS BY THE APPROVED GRANT AMOUNT

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, administered by the Bureau of Justice Assistance under the U.S. Department of Justice, allows state and local governments to support a range of local law enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, this is a non-competitive grant, and the U.S. Department of Justice has already designated an award amount of \$45,571 for the City of Santa Rosa; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice as grantor, requires applicants to obtain government body review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Rosa Police Department has applied for its 2017 JAG allocation in the amount of \$45,571.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Santa Rosa authorizes the City Manager to approve and execute the 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Award Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$45,571, and any amendments thereto, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Chief Financial Officer, upon approval of grant agreement, to increase appropriations in Fund 1213 (Federal Grants) by \$45,571.
