



BID AWARD – 2017 CRANE MASTER TYPE 9 FOOT UTILITY BODIES

CURRENT

- The Water Department needs to replace aging equipment that is at the end of its useful lifespan.
- Under the City's guidelines for replacement of fleet vehicles, the Transportation and Public Works Department Fleet Management Division is responsible for the management and replacement of equipment when it has reached the end of its cost effective life cycle.

CURRENT (Continued)

- On September 21, 2016, IFB 16-76 was opened for four (4) Crane Master Type 9 foot Utility Bodies.
- These four (4) bodies will be affixed to newer truck chassis and will replace existing equipment that is used by the Mechanical Services Technicians at the Laguna Water Treatment Plant.

PROPOSED

- 116 vendors were notified through Planet Bids of Invitation for Bid 16-76, opened on September 21, 2016.
- Four responses were received and two were considered responsive and responsible to the bid requirements.

PROPOSED (Continued)

Vendor	Bid Item 1
Diamond Truck Body MFG Stockton, CA	\$128,954.75
Fortress Resources Paramount, CA	\$139,188.46

BENEFIT

- Purchasing new utility bodies for the previously purchased truck chassis will allow the Mechanical Services Technicians to perform their tasks without downtime.
- There will be less maintenance with more efficient cranes to assist in lifting heavy equipment.

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended by the Finance and Transportation and Public Works Departments, that the Council, by motion, approve this bid award and issuance of a purchase order to Diamond Truck Body MFG, Stockton, California, in the amount \$128,954.75.
